

## IMPROVEMENT OF PEDESTRIAN AND CYCLING SAFETY ADJACENT TO KAPUNDA PRIMARY SCHOOL

Light Regional Council is pleased to announce that pedestrian and cycling safety has been significantly improved as a result of the recent upgrade of footpaths adjacent to Kapunda Primary School. The works included a new paved footpath in Mildred Street from High Street to the school crossing, installation of pram ramps and the installation of Way2Go directional/educational signage.

This project was made possible with funding through the Department of Planning, Transport and Infrastructure's *Way2Go Program* and also funding from Council.





The *Way2Go Program* is a South Australian program promoting safer, greener and more active travel for primary school students and their communities.
